Strategic Corporate Priorities – 2019

In December of 2018, Lytton Council and Senior Staff undertook a Strategic Priorities planning session. Following is an overview of the projects and activities where Village resources will be assigned over the course of this year.

In process/Immediate priorities:

- Meeting with Lytton First Nation Council regarding common goals
- Official Community Plan – developing Terms of Reference
- Business Strategy – developing an action plan for Economic/Community Development
- Housing Strategy – research options
- Ground Water Project – continued oversight and management

As the above goals are achieved, the following priorities will be addressed:

- Subdivision Service Bylaw
- 5 Year Capital Plan
- Community/Economic Development Function
- Water Master Plan

Council has also identified several key priorities where they will work to ensure that the needs of the Village are met through advocacy and partnerships. These include:

- Stakeholder status in the Lytton Elementary School reconfiguration (School District 74)
- Ensuring the sustainability of St. Bartholomew's Health Centre (IHA)
- Rural Transportation (TNRD)
- Rural Health Access (IHA)
- Recreation Needs Assessment (Lytton Recreation Commission)

Within this framework, Village Staff have developed operational strategies to achieve these priorities while managing the daily business of the Village. Activities in process include: funding applications for ongoing infrastructure improvements, the development of 155 South Main St., procuring a new Fire Truck, incorporating a new Asset Management Software System, the development of a Sewer Master Plan, enhanced Emergency Planning, and Website upgrades.
