1. ORDER:

Mayor O'Connor called the meeting to order at 6.30 p.m. and stated: "This Public Hearing is being convened pursuant to Section 890 of the Local Government Act in order to consider the proposed Village of Lytton 2006 Municipal, Regional District and Hospital Tax Rates Bylaw 584, 2006 and the proposed Village of Lytton 2006 Financial Plan 2006 - 2010 Bylaw 585, 2006

At this public hearing, the public are allowed to make representations to Council and all persons present who believe that their interest in property is affected by the proposed bylaw. The public shall be given a reasonable opportunity to be heard or to present written submissions respecting matters contained in the proposed bylaw.

Members of Council may, if they wish, ask questions of you following your presentation. However, the main function of Council Members this evening is to listen to the views of the public. It is not the function of Council Members at this Public Hearing to debate the merits of the proposed bylaw with individual persons.

Everyone shall be given a reasonable opportunity to be heard at this meeting. No one will be, or should feel, discouraged or prevented from making his or her views heard."

2. BYLAW 584,2006 Municipal, Regional District and Hospital Tax Rates Bylaw:

Administrator Dall presented the 2006 Tax Rates Bylaw.

3. BYLAW 585, 2006 2006 Financial Plan 2006-2010:

Administrator Dall & Mayor O'Connor presented the 2006-2010 Budget and Strategic Plan.
