The Village of Lytton met with Ministry of Environment officials today to learn more about the environmental and hazard assessment they are currently conducting within the Village. The presence of propane tanks and the potential for live ammunition and other hazardous chemicals in homes has increased the risks in the assessment process. The protection of the workers is critical and the citizens of Lytton are asked to fill out a form on the Village website and facebook page if they kept ammunition in their home, or were aware of any buried propane or fuel tanks or other hazards on their property.

The Village is also in conversations with multiple agencies on topics ranging from debris and ash removal to interim housing to funding to rebuilding. While these conversations are preliminary, there is an extremely high degree of interest in supporting ALL the citizens of Lytton in a recovery.

The Village Recovery Operations Centre is established in an office space together with the temporary Village office space in Kamloops. The Village Council are working hard on your behalf and will be meeting virtually tomorrow to approve some actions for moving the recovery process forward.
