Extension of Emergency Support Services (ESS) for Ponderosa Neighbourhood Residents

An extension is now in place so that residents from the Ponderosa and Loring Neighbourhood can continue to receive ongoing Emergency Support Services (ESS) while on evacuation alert. The evacuation status for the Ponderosa Neighbourhood was downgraded from an evacuation order to an evacuation alert earlier on July 23, 2021.

Residents with properties located within an area still under evacuation order will continue to receive ESS services ongoing.

The Loring and Lytton Fire Base areas were also downgraded to an evacuation alert as of July 23, and ESS services are no longer available for residents in these areas, and those residents are able to return to their homes. Residents who wish to return to their homes are encouraged to review the [Resident Handout](#) that highlights important actions and safety information before they return home.

Please find the latest evacuation [status map here](#). Any area under evacuation order must be vacated immediately and not entered until it is deemed safe to do so by the appropriate authorities. An area under evacuation alert may be entered, however residents choosing to be in the area must be ready to leave immediately.

Access to Private Property

The Village of Lytton would like to assure everyone that no one is permitted to enter into or onto privately owned property without written consent from the property owner.

Insurance adjustors representing property owners who have requested their services, will be granted escorted access into the evacuation zone for the purpose of gathering photographic and video evidence for inclusion in their assessment and report, relating to insurance claims that have been made by the property owner.
