APPLY FOR EXTENDED EMERGENCY SUPPORT SERVICES

Residents who have been able to return home but are unable to remain due to various barriers, and would therefore need to continue receiving Emergency Support Services (ESS) must complete an Extraordinary Evacuee Authorization Form. Residents can do so by emailing communication@lytton.ca with their full name, contact information and reason for wanting to remain on ESS.

HIGHWAY 12 REOPENING

The Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure has reopened Highway 12 through the Village of Lytton for people living on the Westside, Botanie Valley and Highway 12 to Lillooet to access medical services, emergency services and other needs.
