REMINDER: DO NOT CONSUME (DNC) ADVISORY RESCINDED

Interior Health Authority (IHA) has reached an agreement to remove the Do Not Consume (DNC) Advisory from the section of the water distribution system supplying the east portion of the Village of Lytton, as well as homes on IR#17 and IR#18.

A review of the comprehensive and bacteriological sample results support rescinding the DNC Advisory. The Village of Lytton will continue to closely monitor the source and distribution water quality. The Village will immediately conduct additional sampling if there are any indications of changes in the source or distribution system water quality and notify IHA.

2021 PROPERTY TAX NOTICES
