



## Village of Lytton Update

### DEMOLITION PERMITS NOW AVAILABLE

Residents, builders and the businesses are now able to apply for Village of Lytton Demolition Permits online. **Please note, anyone with insurance does not need to apply for a permit – your insurance company will handle the application and coordinate debris removal on your behalf.**

Due to the level of contamination throughout the village it has been determined that a coordinated debris removal process will need to be undertaken. The Village will be working with the Canadian Red Cross, Emergency Management BC and the Thomson Nicola Regional District to ensure orderly debris removal for the remaining uninsured properties. Further information will be made available once plans and timelines are determined.

The Village of Lytton is pleased to offer Cloudpermit – an online system to apply for and track your demolition permits. The Cloudpermit permit system allows you to apply for and to see the status of your application at any time. You can start an application and finish it later and receive email updates on the status of your permit application. BC Hydro is working closely with the Village of Lytton, Lytton First Nations, and other stakeholders to rebuild our infrastructure that was destroyed during last year's fire.
