Spring 2022 Election

The 2020 Spring By-Election General will take place on Saturday, April 30.

Join your community in electing two (2) Councillors to the Village of Lytton Council. The nomination period begins March 15. Candidate packages can be requested by emailing corporate@lytton.ca. See the [Notice of Nomination](#).

All eligible Resident Electors and Non-Resident Property Electors may vote in person or by mail. Mail-in ballots can be requested beginning April 4.

As many Village of Lytton residents have been displaced due the fire, you are considered a resident if you intend to return. See more details: <https://lytton.ca/government/2022-lytton-by-election>.

Is your name on the current list of electors?

The Village of Lytton will be using the Provincial List of Voters for Resident Electors in the 2022 Spring By-Election. You can confirm if you are on the Provincial Voters List by calling Elections BC at 1-800-661-8683 or by emailing voterservices@elections.bc.ca. If you are not on the list, you can register in person on Advance or General Voting Day or when your request a mail-in ballot.

Non-Resident Property Electors

The Village of Lytton will maintain a list of Non-Resident Property Electors. You may register by contacting corporate@lytton.ca or visiting Lytton Municipal Hall during regular office hours, Monday to Friday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at Old Towne Inne, Cabin #2, 47555 Trans-Canada Highway, Boston Bar V0K 1C0. Registration will be accepted until March 8.
