



EVACUATION ALERT RESCIND VILLAGE OF LYTTON

March 21, 2022 (03/21/2022) at 16:30 pm

An Evacuation Alert issued by Village of Lytton at the Village Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) program due to the danger to life and safety caused by a wildfire burning near **Mowhokam Creek/ George Rd Wildfire** is hereby rescinded effective Monday, March 21, 2022 at 16:30 hours. All properties in the rescind area are now ALL CLEAR of restrictions. The areas now downgraded to ALL CLEAR status are:

- **Kumsheen Secondary School – 365 Trans Canada Hwy**
- **Pines Motel – 150 Trans Canada Hwy**
- **Ponderosa Heights**
- **Loring Way**
- **Kent Road**

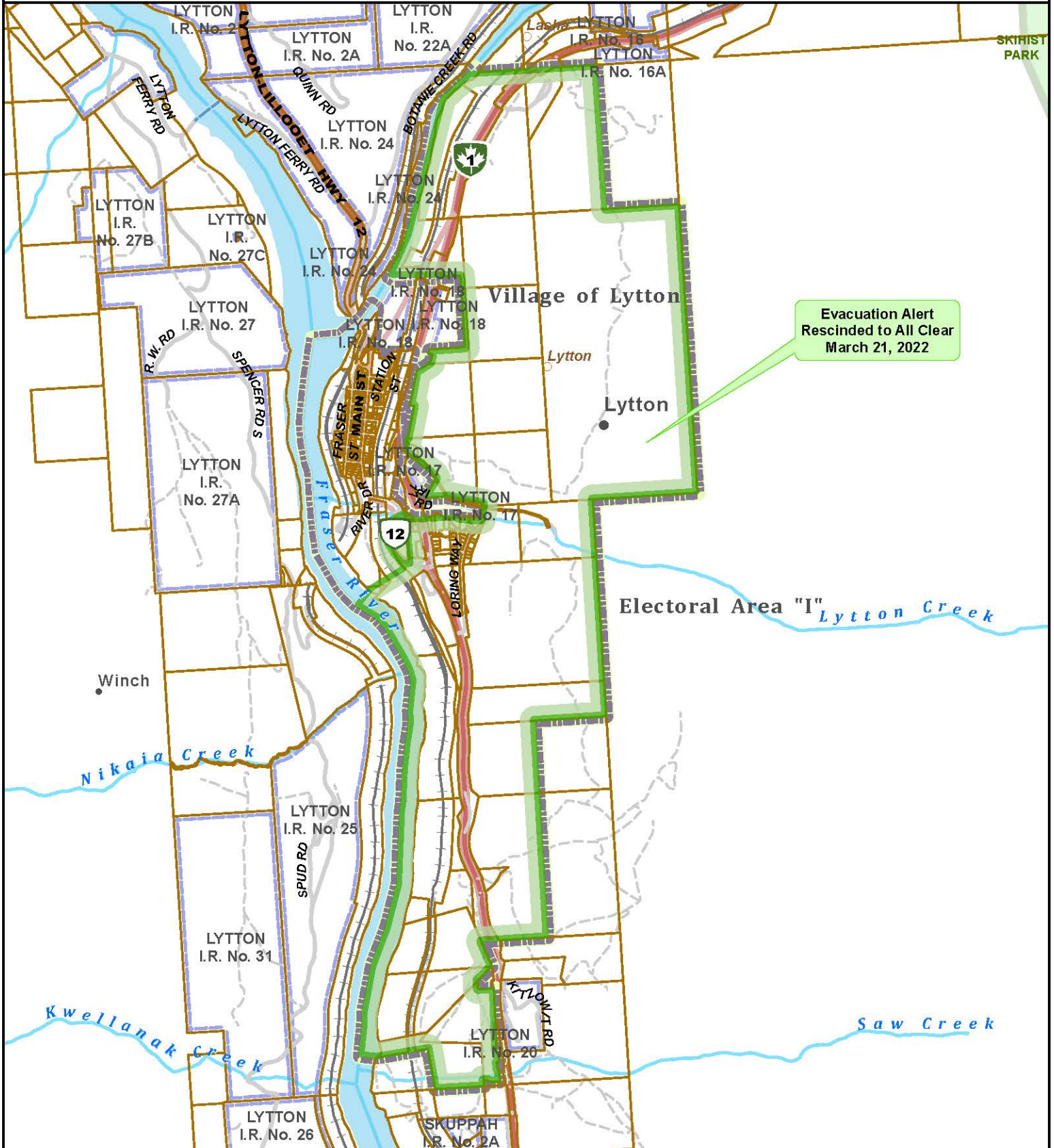

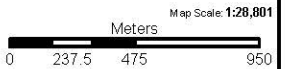
