## Qualifications for Office

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day of October 15, 2022;
- resident of British Columbia for at least six months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed;
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

## Campaign period expense limits

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2022 General Election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

Mayor: \$10,797.83

Councillor: \$5,398.92

## Third Party Advertising Limits

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2022 General Election, the following third-party advertising limits apply:

Third Party Advertising Limit: \$809.84  
Cumulative Third-Party Advertising Limit: \$161,967.47
