



BOIL WATER NOTICE

On the night of March 27, 2023, we experienced a power outage at the Water Treatment Plant. Due to the SCADA system not working properly this outage was discovered at 7:00 am March 28, 2023. Due to this power outage we had to fill the reservoirs manually using raw creek water. We also manually dosed with sodium hypochlorite to provide some level of disinfection. Due to the Ultraviolet disinfection being inoperable disease-causing organisms [bacteria, viruses, or parasites] may have entered the distribution system. These organisms can cause symptoms such as diarrhea, abdominal cramps, headaches, nausea, vomiting or other symptoms. Boiling the water will kill these organisms. People with weakened or undeveloped immune systems are most at risk [this includes elderly people, pregnant women, and their unborn, very young children [under 2], people with AIDS, cancer, diabetes or kidney disease and people being treated with immuno-suppressing medications].

Water users are advised to bring all water to a rolling boil for at least one minute and let it cool before using it or, use bottled water. Boiled or bottled water should be used for drinking, making ice, washing dishes, brushing teeth and food preparation until further notice. We will inform you when you no longer need to boil your water.

THIS BOIL WATER NOTICE IS EFFECTIVE March 28, 2023 UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.
