PUBLIC NOTICE BYLAW NO. 742, 2023

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ALTERNATIVE MEANS OF PUBLISHING A NOTICE

WHEREAS the *Community Charter* and *Local Government Act* require local governments to provide advance public notice on certain matters of public interest to facilitate the opportunity for public participation in local government decision-making;

AND WHEREAS section 94.1 of the *Community Charter* sets out the default publication requirements to publish public notices in a newspaper once a week for two consecutive weeks for such matters;

AND WHEREAS section 94.2 of the *Community Charter* authorizes that Council may, by bylaw, provide for alternative means of publishing a public notice for such matters;

AND WHEREAS Council has considered the principles for effective public notice that include that the mean of publication is reliable, suitable and accessible as prescribed in *Public Notice Regulation 52/2022*;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Village of Lytton, in open meeting assembled, hereby **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Public Notice Bylaw No. 742, 2023".

2. PUBLIC NOTICE

The means of publication for public notice requirements under the *Community Charter*; *Local Government Act*, or any other enactment shall be delivered in the following form and manner:

- (a) Electronically by posting the notice on the Village of Lytton's website.
- (b) Electronically by distributing the notice through the Village of Lytton's email subscription list.

3. ADDITIONAL NOTICES

The notice requirements set forth in this bylaw are minimum requirements and are not intended to limit Council's discretion to direct staff to provide additional notices, utilizing different or additional method of notice, as deemed appropriate by Council.

4. SEVERABILITY

If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or word in his bylaw is held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the invalid portion will be severed, and the remainder of the bylaw will be deemed to be adopted without the severed part.
