How to request sewer service

Reconnection to the Village of Lytton (Village) sewer system is available to residents and businesses, as you begin to rebuild your property.

Restoring sewer services

As part of its recovery efforts, the Village of Lytton has been restoring sewer and water services.

In fall 2023, the Village contracted services to prepare for new sewer connections. This work included inspecting and flushing sewer lines, verifying existing as-built drawings, and recommending priorities for maintenance and repair. Information gathered from this work will help inform future investments in the sewer system.

Residential sewer connection

The Village will provide sewer service to your property line with a standard 4" service to the curb stop at no charge to you. If you wish to request a different service, an estimated cost will be provided by the Village for this alternative service.

The turnaround time for service is 30 days unless issues are identified during the Village's site-specific assessment.

Commercial sewer connection

The Village will assess your needs on a property-specific basis, depending on the intended commercial use.

As with residential service, a standard 4" service to the curb stop will be provided free of charge. The cost of any changes to this service will be estimated by the Village. The turnaround time for service is 30 days unless issues are identified during the Village's site-specific assessment.

Process

1. [Complete the application for sewer service](#). Considerations for sewer service include Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure (MoTI) and archaeology requirements, and any necessary BC Hydro communication or coordination.
2. Public Works will complete a site-specific assessment to confirm availability and timing of service.
3. Scheduling for the connection will be confirmed.
4. Connection takes place.
